

THE AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE SIX NATION INDIAN MUSEUM, ONCHIOTA, N.Y.

- (1) TO ENLIGHTEN THE PUBLIC TOWARD A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE INDIAN RACE, OF THEIR GREAT HISTORY AND OF THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS TO WORLD CULTURE.
- (2) TO ERECT AT LEAST ONE MONUMENT OR MEMORIAL EACH YEAR TO NOTED IROQUOIS LEADERS, PAST OR PRESENT, OR TO IMPORTANT IROQUOIS EVENTS.
- (3) TO MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR OUR YOUNG PEOPLE TO VISIT SCENIC AND HISTORICAL PLACES IN THE NEAR AND DISTANT REGIONS SURROUNDING THE ST. REGIS COUNTRY.
- (4) TO MAKE IT POSSIBLE FOR OUR YOUNG PEOPLE, MEMBERS OF THE AKWESASNE MOHAWK COUNSELOR ORGANIZATION, TO HELP, BY GIVING THEIR TIME, KNOWLEDGE AND TALENT, CERTAIN WORTHWHILE INDIAN PROJECTS SUCH AS INDIAN PAGEANTS, FAIRS, CEREMONIALS AND SUCH WHOSE PURPOSE IS TO PRESENT TO THE PUBLIC THE TRUE HISTORY OF THE INDIAN.
- (5) TO GIVE OUR INDIAN YOUTH, THROUGH OUR IROQUOIS CHARTS AND PAMPHLETS, A MEANS OF PRESERVING THEIR GREAT HISTORY AND CULTURE SO THAT THEY WILL ALWAYS HAVE IT. A KNOWLEDGE OF THE TRUE HISTORY OF THE INDIAN RACE IS A NECESSARY KNOWLEDGE FOR THE WELFARE OF OUR INDIAN YOUTH. YOUNG PEOPLE, AMERICANS OF ALL COLORS, SHOULD KNOW OF THE GREAT IROQUOIS CONFEDERACY, THE ROCK UPON WHICH THE AMERICAN NATION WAS FOUNDED AND THEY SHOULD FEEL PROUD OF THEIR INDIAN HERITAGE.
- (6) TO ENABLE US TO HELP PUT THROUGH COLLEGE THOSE OF OUR INDIAN YOUNG PEOPLE WHO SHOW SPECIAL TALENT BUT WHO, THROUGH CIRCUMSTANCES, LACK THE NECESSARY FUNDS TO ATTAIN THAT GOAL.
