2 supplement, for the definition, qualification, or limitation
3 of any powers which may be granted, in any manner
4 deemed necessary or desirable for the effectuation of the
5 purposes and policies above set forth.

6 (a) To organize and act as a Federal municipal
7 corporation, to establish a form of government, to adopt
8 and thereafter to amend a constitution, and to promulgate
9 and enforce ordinances and regulations for the effectuation
10 of the functions hereafter specified, and any other functions
11 customarily exercised by local governments.

12 (b) To elect or appoint officers, agents, and employ-
13 ees, to define the qualifications for office, to fix the salaries
14 of officials to be paid by the community, to prescribe the
15 qualifications of voters, to define the conditions of member-
16 ship within the community, and to provide for the adoption
17 of new members.

18 (c) To regulate the use and disposition of property
19 by members of the community, to protect and conserve the
20 property, wild life, and natural resources of the community,
21 to cultivate and encourage arts, crafts, and culture, to
22 administer charity, and to protect the health, morals, and
23 general welfare of the members of the community.

24 (d) To establish courts for the enforcement and admin-
