

1 reasonably necessary to assure the continued and the satis-
2 factory administration of transferred functions or services.

3 Any Indian community may, through procedure set up
4 in its charter, appoint a member to any vacant position under
5 the Indian Service maintained for the administration of
6 functions or services for Indians within the territorial limits
7 of the community. The appointee shall not take office until
8 he shall have previously received the certificate of approval
9 of his fitness for the position in question from the Com-
10 missioner. The Commissioner shall issue such certificate
11 of approval to any member of an Indian community recom-
12 mended by the duly authorized representatives of the
13 community and who is qualified for the position under the
14 rules and regulations prescribed pursuant to this section.

15 Any Indian community may, upon a three-fourths vote
16 at a popular election open to all adult members, request
17 the transfer of any separable function or service, and the
18 Secretary of the Interior shall transfer such function or
19 service and, if necessary, confer by supplement to the com-
20 munity charter, the legal capacity to exercise such function
21 or service, subject only to the following terms and conditions;

22 (a) The community must comply with all conditions
23 prescribed by the rules and regulations of the Secretary
24 of the Interior pursuant to the authority of this section.
25 The community may transmit to the Congress any objection
