

1 the conditions imposed for the continued administration of  
2 the function or service transferred, the Secretary or the  
3 Commissioner of Indian Affairs shall reassume the admin-  
4 istration of such function or service and the Secretary shall  
5 report to the next regular session of the Congress with  
6 appropriate recommendations.

7 (e) The community, or its duly authorized representa-  
8 tives, shall make on or before September 1 of each year,  
9 an annual report for the fiscal year ended June 30, pre-  
10 viously, to the Secretary, concerning the administration  
11 of the function or service transferred to the community,  
12 including an account by the disbursing agent of the com-  
13 munity of receipts and expenditures of moneys placed to  
14 the credit of the community under this section.

15 (f) The Secretary of the Interior shall make an  
16 annual report to Congress on the administration of the  
17 functions and services transferred to the community, and  
18 shall include in such report the reports of the Indian  
19 communities required by paragraph (e) of this section.

20 SEC. 9. The Secretary and the Commissioner shall  
21 continue to exercise all existing powers of supervision and  
22 control over Indian affairs now entrusted to them or either  
23 of them which are not transferred by charter or supplement  
24 thereto or by Act of Congress to organized Indian com-  
25 munities, and shall have power to enforce by administrative
