- 1 the conditions imposed for the continued administration of
- 2 the function or service transferred, the Secretary or the
- 3 Commissioner of Indian Affairs shall reassume the admin-
- 4 istration of such function or service and the Secretary shall
- 5 report to the next regular session of the Congress with
- 6 appropriate recommendations.
- 7 (e) The community, or its duly authorized representa-
- 8 tives, shall make on or before September 1 of each year,
- 9 an annual report for the fiscal year ended June 30, pre-
- 10 viously, to the Secretary, concerning the administration
- 11 of the function or service transferred to the community,
- 12 including an account by the disbursing agent of the com-
- 13 munity of receipts and expenditures of moneys placed to
- 14 the credit of the community under this section.
- 15 (f) The Secretary of the Interior shall make an
- 16 annual report to Congress on the administration of the
- 17 functions and services transferred to the community, and
- 18 shall include in such report the reports of the Indian
- 19 communities required by paragraph (e) of this section.
