Formal contracts shall not be required for compliance 2 with section 3744 of the Revised Statutes (U.S.C., title 41, sec. 16), with respect to the grants of subsidies or scholar-3 ships to Indian students under the foregoing provisions. 4 Sec. 2. It is hereby declared to be the purpose and 5 policy of Congress to promote the study of Indian civilization 6 and preserve and develop the special cultural contributions 7 8 and achievements of such civilization, including Indian arts, 9 crafts, skills, and traditions. The Commissioner is directed to prepare curricula for Indian schools adapted to the needs 10 and capacities of Indian students, including courses in Indian 11 history, Indian arts and crafts, the social and economic 12 problems of the Indians, and the history and problems of 13 the Indian Administration. The Commissioner is authorized 14 to employ individuals familiar with Indian culture and with 15 the contemporary social and economic problems of the 16 Indians to instruct in schools maintained for Indians. 17 The 18 Commissioner is further directed to make available the 19 facilities of the Indian schools to competent individuals appointed or employed by an Indian community to instruct 20 the elementary and secondary grades in the Indian arts, 2122 crafts, skills, and traditions. The Commissioner may contribute to the compensation of such individuals in such 23 proportion and upon such terms and conditions as he may 24
