deem advisable. For this purpose the Commissioner may
 use moneys appropriated for the maintenance of such schools.

## TITLE III—INDIAN LANDS

4 SECTION 1. It is hereby declared to be the policy of Congress to undertake a constructive program of Indian 5 land use and economic development, in order to establish 6 7 a permanent basis of self-support for Indians living under Federal tutelage; to reassert the obligations of guardianship 8 9 where such obligations have been improvidently relaxed; 10 to encourage the effective utilization of Indian lands and 11 resources by Indian tribes, cooperative associations, and 12 chartered communities; to safeguard Indian lands against alienation from Indian ownership and against physical 13 14 deterioration; and to provide land needed for landless Indians and for the consolidation of Indian landholdings in suitable 15 economic units. 16

17 SEC. 2. Hereafter no tribal or other land of any Indian 18 reservation or community created or set apart by treaty 19 or agreement with the Indians, act of Congess, Executive 20 order, purchase, or otherwise, shall be allotted in severalty 21 to any Indian.

SEC. 3. The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to
withdraw from disposal the remaining surplus lands of any
Indian reservation heretofore opened or authorized to be
