All rights of exclusive occupancy of, and all physical 1 $\mathbf{2}$ improvements lawfully erected on, tribal or community 3 lands, shall descend according to rules of descent and distribution to be prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior. 4 $\mathbf{5}$ SEC. 10. Wherever the Secretary shall find that exist-6 ing State laws governing the determination of heirs, so far 7 as made applicable to any restricted Indian lands by con-8 gressional enactment, are not adapted to Indian needs and circumstances, he may promulgate independent rules gov-9 erning such determination, including such rules as may 10 11 be necessary to prevent any subdivision of rights to lands 12or improvements thereon which is likely to impair their 13 beneficial use.

14 The Secretary may delegate to a chartered Indian15 community the authority conferred by this section.

16 SEC. 11. On and after the effective date of the passage of this Act, and beginning with the death of the person 17 presently entitled, all right, interest, and title in restricted 18 allotted lands, but not including any proportionate interest 19 acquired pursuant to section 8 of this title or any improve-20ments lawfully erected, shall pass to the chartered com- $\mathbf{21}$ munity within whose territorial limits such lands are located $\mathbf{22}$ or, if no community has been chartered, to the tribe from 23whose lands the allotment was made: Provided, however, 24 H.
