The Secretary may delegate to a chartered community 1 2 the authority conferred by this section and may countersign certificates of interest issued by such community to its 3 members. 4 SEC. 14. The Secretary of the Interior is authorized 5 and directed to classify and divide the lands owned or con-6 trolled by an Indian tribe or community into economic units 7 suitable for farming, grazing, forestry, and other purposes, 8 and may lease or permit the use of, and may regulate the 9 10 use and management of, such lands whenever in his opinion 11 necessary to promote and preserve their economic use. Secretary may delegate to a chartered Indian community 12 the authority conferred by this section. 13 SEC. 15. The Secretary of the Interior is authorized 14 and directed to make rules and regulations for the operation 15 and management of Indian forestry units on the principle 16 of sustained yield management, to restrict the number of 17 18 livestock grazed on Indian range units to the estimated 19 carrying capacity of such ranges, and to promulgate such other rules and regulations as may be necessary to protect 20 the range from deterioration, to prevent soil erosion, and 21 like purposes. The Secretary may delegate to a chartered 22 Indian community the authority conferred by this section. 23 Sec. 16. The Secretary of the Interior is authorized 24 25 to proclaim new Indian reservations on lands purchased for
