country, and it is safe to assert, that on reservations everywhere, Indians can be found wearing these popular robes.

Other Uses

It is only within the last few years that the white people have discovered how useful one of these robes is about the house.

They were first used by a few enthusiasts for decorations in fancy corners and Indian collections. Others soon discovered that they were just the thing for couch and lounge covers, slumber robes, veranda wraps, steamer rugs, driving robes, for traveling and for hundreds of other uses, and now, besides being a luxury and a novelty, they are also a necessity.

When thrown across the foot of the bed, they appear to be only ornamental, but in the wee small hours of the early morn, when the thermometer commences to crawl down towards the freezing point, they prove to be just the thing to be drawn up over the bed for an extra covering.

In the sick room they are invaluable, as they are light and warm, and for the convalescent, make an excellent wrap while sitting up in bed or for the sick person sitting in a chair.
