However in my research I have found the following maps: A map of the Battle of the Rosebud in "My Story" by Anson Mills, edited by C. H. Claudy pages 399 and 403. I have found in the folder files a scale map of forty-one Indian battles giving the names of the commanding officers, name of the Indians, the locality, etc.; this includes the Hayfield Fight, The Wagon Box Fight, the attack on Crazy Horse's village, and the Rosebud Fight.
