There are some other pictures I will change, too. I have a good one of Red Leaf which I'll substitute for the amateur photo I have there now. I also have a photo by Morrow, titled "Gen. Crook appointing Spotted Tail chief of the Sioux," which I want to put in somewhere, either as a substitute, or otherwise.

I don't believe that the photo of Iron Nation (American Horse) killed at Slim Buttes is authentic, either. However, we shall see about that. I'm trying to find out who took the various pictures of the Wounded Knee fight, but there seems to be no agreement on that. Will have to put my partner, in Washington, to work.
