The next settlement invaded was that on the Sappa, at Oberlin P. O. and village. I found most of the victims from both branches of the Sappa. I placed them in the order in which their places are located on the stream, beginning at the forks and going upwards on the South Sappa.

18 Margareth Smith, widow of James G. Smith, her husband was killed Sept. 30. He lived at the forks but was killed 4 miles up the Creek, lost one span of horses and harness 345.00

19 Sarah Hudson widow of John C. Hudson, her husband was killed with Smith with whom he was living, lost:
one span of mules and harness 430.00
