MILITARY SERVICE AND TRAINING PRIOR TO EMERGENCY.

Aug. 19, 1888 to Aug. 27, 1894, Pvt., 22d. Infantry, N.G.N.Y.

Jan. 1, 1916 to May 30, 1916, Cpl., Civilian Engineers Training Bat., N. Y. City (Nucleus 1st. Res. Eng., afterward 11th. Eng.).

Sept. 8, 1916 to Oct. 5, 1916, Cpl. and Sgt., 10th. Training Regt., U. S. Military Training Camp, Plattsburg, N. Y. under special U. S. Army enlistment oath.

Nov. 6, 1916, Commissioned Major, Q. M. R. C., U. S. Army.

DUTIES PERFORMED IN MILITARY SERVICE OF UNITED STATES.

Aug. 6, 1917, Assigned to active duty as Ass't. to Gen. Supt. A. T. S. N. Y. as Officer in Charge of Construction.

Nov. 1, 1917, Organized C. & R. Division A. T. S. N. Y. and appointed Officer in Charge. Jurisdiction extended to all dock, wharf and terminal properties operated by A. T. S.

May 29, 1918, Assigned to organize and appointed Officer in Charge of Supplies Inspection Branch, Sup. Div., O. P. U. O. N. Y. Jurisdiction embracing inspection of all supplies furnished by Army for Embarkation Service, Port of N. Y.

Dec. 3, 1918, Appointed Officer in Charge of Purchase Branch, O. P. U. O. N. Y. Immediate jurisdiction in purchase of all supplies furnished by Army for Embarkation Service.

Mar. 24, 1919, Transferred at own request to duty as Q. M. troop movement officer, Transportation Div. O. P. U. O. N. Y. for instruction in transportation duties, embarking, debarking and entraining troops.

June 3, 1919, Transferred to P. & Z. T. O. N. Y. as Officer in Charge of Administrative Div. and immediate general assistant to Executive Officer. Later Acting Executive Officer.

Oct. 30, 1919, Honorable discharged.
