them most assuredly the controul of the Northern Indians.

Until this is accomplished you will no doubt be continually harrassed with their depredations in small parties. I most sincerely wish that you could obtain the permission of the Government to join me. The management of the defensive war for the protection of the frontiers might I should suppose be entrusted to another. Be pleased to transmit to the Asst Adj Genls office at Franklinton a return of all the troops under your command as speedily as possible---
