

Dow a cattle herder for Mr. Kinsley was killed. On the 13th of Sept, 1878 at E. W. Payne's Ranch on Salt Fork, were wounded, Walter Payne, leg broken and thumb shot off, Charles Payne 3 years old shot in body, and Nora E. Payne, 1 year old shot through breast, breaking top of left shoulder. Property taken from Mr. Payne, six (6) horses, forty (40) beef cattle, three (3) saddles, three (3) guns, five (5) bridles, one (1) set (2 horses) harness, one hundred dollars worth of provisions, seventy five (75) dollars worth of clothing and two hundred (200) dollars worth of household and kitchen furniture about sixteen hundred (1600) dollars in all. On the same date as above viz. 12th of Sept, Hunter and Evans lost one (1) horse and twenty (20) head of cattle on the Hoscontanga.

On the 12th of Sept. at D. Sheedge Camp on Cavalry Creek five (5) miles East from Frasers Camp on Kiowa, was killed John Evans, a herder of Mr. Sheedge. At same camp Mr. Sheedge lost thirteen (13) horses, twenty (20) lbs. bacon, one sharpe carbine, four (4) pr. blankets, four (4) suits of clothes, one (1) wagon sheet, (bake ovens, coffee pot, plates, cups, knives and forks, fifteen dollars worth) one (1) keg syrup (5 gal), one (1) saddle, saddle bags one (1) axil, four (4) picket ropes, all valued at sixteen hundred and thirty five (1635) dollars.

At Henry Kollar's Camp in Bluff Creek on the 13th of Sept 1878, Warren Richardson was killed, and two men, strangers to Mr. Kollar, were wounded, names unknown. Mr. Kollar lost, eight (8) horses, fifty (50) head of cattle, camp outfit, 150 lbs. flour, nine (9) pr blankets, one (1) 5 gal. keg syrup, fifty (50) pds coffee, one buggy and harness, one trunk with shirts and under clothing and \$20.00 in money. In all eighteen hundred (1800) dollars worth. At Biddle and Spencers Camp on Bluff Creek six miles above mouth of Cavalry Creek was taken and destroyed. One (1) horse of Biddle & Spencers, one (1) horse of William Loughty, a herder, one (1) bull killed valued at \$100.00. One (1) steer killed, four (4) blankets (single). one suit clothes, under clothing and shirts, cooking utensils, plate, knives, forks, spoons and twenty (20) lbs. coffee, 100
