Sir:

It having come to the knowledge of the Commanding officer that you have been rehauling the goods hauled from Ranch known as Wheelers Ranche, and deposited in your house, I am directed by the commanding officer to warn you that this practice must cease.

No traders are permitted at this Post or on this Reservation except those duly authorized by the government, and it is the duty of the Commanding officer to protect those duly authorized in their just rights.

It is a matter of surprise to the Commanding Officer that an officer of the Army should engage in a pursuit so foreign to the legitimate duties of of his profession, particularly when he cannot be ignorant that such a pursuit is, under the existing rules and regulations of this post, improper and in violation of the same.
