The process was instituted on the presentinent of F. F. Jones late Interpretor and Milliam Seamore (alias Apache Bill) assisted and conducted by Chaplain A. G. White and Citizen S. P. Wheelor as a retalitory measure.

I respectfully ask to be permitted to employ counsil for the above named officers and myself as this proceeding is instituted by reason of my official acts—and I would also respectfully ask that the counsellors be designated by Dept. Hd. Qrs as I am ignorant of the legal capacity of any lawyer in the state.
