I have the honor to report the following
relative to the movements of Indians since last Report.

On the 1st inst "Spotted Wolf's" band of Apaches numbering 15 men
coming from the Ute Country passed through this Post en route to Fort Larned,
Kas, and "Bull Bear's" band of Dog Soldiers numbering 20 men passed through
going to the South branch of the Pawnee, and recd three days rations.

On the 5th inst, "Powder Face's" band of Arrapahoes numbering 2 men,
2 women and 7 childred and "Spotted Wolf's" band numbering 40 men 28 women and 72
