CHEROKEE PIONEER DIES

Mrs. Lydia Reagan, 83, Lived in Oklahoma 50 Years.

TAHLEQUAH, Oct. 22 (Special) Mrs. Lydia Reagan, 83, is dead here. Among the oldest citizens of Cherokee county, Mrs. Reagan had lived in this section for the past 50 years. Her first husband, named Potts, was employed in erecting the Cherokee national asylum for the mentally deficient, in 1876.

Her second marriage was to Michael Reagan, whose death at an advanced age occurred several years ago.

Mrs. Reagan was the daughter of Jay Hicks, a pioneer of the old Indian Territory and a judge of the Indian court in the period preceding the outbreak of the civil war. Two sons and a daughter survive.

This woman was the wife of Reagan the Carpenter who builded my house in Tahlequah with McGregor & Frenchy, & Jerry Springsted prior to 1874 - & when Dick Dammerting now lives -
