Pension Civil War Widows.  
WASHINGTON, Feb. 21 (A. P.)  
A bill to grant a flat \$50 monthly  
pension to all widows and remar-  
ried widows of Civil war veterans  
was passed unanimously by the  
house today, and sent to the sen-  
ate.

The above clipping shows more complication  
in pension allowances than ever--no prior  
acts repealed, nor stating who those widows  
are--status not explained--good as far as  
it goes yet the power that allows may say  
one thing and the law another--  
Even retroaction allowed to precall--  
and the acts of the Cherokee Nation and  
people, in their customs, usages and rites  
ruthlessly set aside and consrued adversely  
to their inherited and inalienable rights as  
guaranteed ny the U. S. Govt in its guarantees  
to the rights of the Cherokee people and their  
Nations usages, customs and rights--
