**PENSION FIELD WIDENED**

Veterans of Indian Wars, From  
1859 to 1898, to Get Fund.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 22 (Spe-  
cial) - Many aged Texans and Okla-  
homans who participated in Indian  
warfare from 1859 to 1898, will be  
pensioned if the senate concurs in  
a bill passed by the house today.  
The bill makes eligible for pen-  
sion any person who served 30 days  
or more in any Indian war. It will  
care for a class of soldiers which  
the present pension laws did not  
reach. Many of the men made el-  
gible for pensions are reported to  
be in want. Such soldiers who  
have reached the age of 68 are en-  
titled to pensions of \$30 per month,  
men who have reached the age of  
72, \$40 a month, and 75, \$50 a  
month.

The above shows that some  
soldiers favored & others ignored  
as to rights to pension.

Pension Laws discriminating  
& too while not so allowed.

In one law allowed pension  
without regard to soldiers  
condition is physically, another  
law denies pension to soldiers  
physically barred by pension law.
