

My Aunt Abigail Elliott
 was afflicted as I am
 had - unable to hold her
 head still, & frequently falling
 & hurting herself - She
 was so afflicted from my
 first recollection -
 in about 1885 or
 1890 she was unable at
 all to keep herself - Com-
 pelled to keep her bed always -
 I placed her in the home
 of J for her care at Tah-
 le-guak -
 what became of her I
 know not after the home
 was abandoned -

Paralyzed on right side,
 in the early 80's 1880's
 traveled for relief all over
 United States - Spent \$1750 -
 to get relief - then,

Paralyzed again in 1899 or
 1900 - at Sallisaw & moved
 from there to Vian for relief -
 my first stroke was at
 Tah-le-guak, & Dr. Fife treated
 me, & had me travel for
 relief - my second stroke at
 Sallisaw -

Had two severe attacks of
 Pneumonia at Tah-le-guak -
 Very severe indeed - & just
 prior to 1888 & 1893 -
 about not exact - my
 first attack was by Congestion
 of the chest & I lay for 40 days
 before recovery -

At Sallisaw & Vian lingered
 for nearly 5 months - made
 another extended trip over the
 U.S. to Washington D.C., New-
 York & San Francisco -
 Dr. Hudson of Sallisaw treated
