Meets at Hulbert August 11.HULBERT, July 25 (Special)—  
The seventy-first anniversary of  
the establishment of the Keetoowah  
society of the Cherokee nation  
will be recalled when the conven-  
tion of that organization convenes  
here on August 11. Five days will  
be devoted to subjects of interest.  
The evening of the eleventh will be  
devoted to singing in the native  
language, the leaders being John  
Cochran, Richard Fourkiller, Josiah  
Locust and Mary Coon. On Sunday,  
following, there will be preaching  
all day, participated in by several  
full-blood Cherokee ministers and  
by President B. D. Weeks of Bacone  
university.
