War — War — War —

A Kilometer is $\frac{1}{1600}$ of a
mile —

an advance of $3\frac{1}{2}$ kilo-
meters on a 4 mile front
means an advance of
2 miles on a $2\frac{1}{2}$ mile

front. — distance measurements

What Kilometer Actually Means

A kilometer is equivalent to
62-100 miles.

The dispatch from the French
front declaring that the Marines
had advanced "3½ kilometers on
a four-mile front" means that the
Americans advanced 2 miles on
a 2½-mile front.

The gain in terrain, naturally
equals about five square miles—
and that much territory, won at
the point of the bayonet at a
place where all reports show the
fighting was heaviest, indicates
that the Marines again "made
good" on the job assigned them.
