Is Desire of a
Louisville Man

St. Louis, June 25.—Declaring he wished President Wilson would intern Col. Theodore Roosevelt for the period of the war and urging his hearers to thank God for giving them such a leader as Wilson, Dr. Charles Wakefield Welch, pastor of the Fourth Presbyterian church of Louisville, Ky., addressed members of the Advertising Club here today.

"I thank God that such a man is at our head today," Dr. Welch declared. "All hail to Woodrow Wilson and to the devil with Roosevelt! These two men stand out in strong contrast; one ambitious, seeking his own selfish ends, the other self-sacrificing and working silently to lift this nation up as the beacon light of all the rest; one crying 'Intern all the Germans,' the other one—I wish he would say—'Intern Teddy.'"
