Also a Mr. Moore from Van Buren, Ark--also a Mr. Marchant, his wife & Boy--

Boarded with Mr. W. W. Ward all the time-- at \$5.50 per week.

While there secured the med assistance of Dr. Jesse Bushyhead--to treat me clear through my ailment--

While there met John Parris, Harrison Williams, Mrs. 2m. Johnson, and C. V. Rogers-- & Bean Burgess and two of the Chamberses--& others--

My disease was contracted at Ft. Smith in 1895--cured as I supposed till Nov 1907--when it broke out in severe form--and now 2--14-08 recovering--

Such appears to be life with its ups and downs, ins and outs--
