Sallie Thornton---two cases--

Letter of inquiry to the Com of the general land office after  
the land provided for ex-soldiers of the civil war--for herself  
as sole surviving heir to soldiers estate--the soldier, Crawler  
was her father, and died in the service near Cane Hill, Ark  
in the year 1862, and supposedly in Nov. see copy of request in  
files and the official letter of the pension Com.

Another matter, is that of her child Jennie Yabola  
who died June 24, 1915--  
Sallies roll # is 20533--at the age of 50--  
Jennies roll # is 20537--at the age of 27--

It has been reported to Sallie that there was money on de-  
posit at the Agency of Jennies, , amount unknown--  
and by blood relation descends to Sallie--  
after same inquiry is made--this April 1st, 1924--

My charge in the Jennie Yabola case  
on each dollar received 30 per cent -  
and incidentals one dollar - Now -  
on the land matter - no charge  
or demand made -

In both cases requests mailed
