- 1886—Graduated by Cincinnati, Ohio,  
Law School.
- 1887—Practiced law in Lincoln, Neb.
- 1889—Married Miss Cora D. Blymer of  
Cincinnati.
- 1894—Moved to Evanston, Ill., and be-  
came interested in a gas property  
project.
- 1896—Successfully managed McKinley's  
campaign in Illinois.
- 1898—Became controller of the currency.
- 1902—Organized Central Trust company  
of Illinois.
- 1917—Became purchasing agent for the  
A. E. F.
- 1921—Director of the budget.
- 1924—Chairman of Experts' Committee  
on Reparation.
- 1924—Elected vice president, United  
States of America.
