COURT SLASHES ATTORNEY FEES

Only \$7,500, Instead of \$56,000 Allowed in Pitman Cases

By the Associated Press Staff Wire. MUSKOGEE, Dec. 16.—Attorneys fees aggregating \$7,500 instead of the \$56,000 asked were allowed Monday by County Judge W. W. Cotner in the Lucinda Pitman and Wilcox Pitman guardianship cases. The suit originally was instituted to appoint the guardians, Joe McMurray and A. H. Davison, who had increased the estate of Wilson Pitman from nothing to \$140,000 and the estate of Lucinda Pitman from less than a quarter of a million to more than a half million dollars. The amounts asked and the sums allowed were as follows: William Naff, asked \$16,000, allowed \$2,500; Cooper and Whitaker, Choctaw, asked \$10,000, allowed \$500; Ed Frye, Sallisaw, asked \$1,000, allowed \$1,500; Hubert and Nichols, Eufaula, asked \$10,000, allowed \$500; Roselle Cole, niece of Lucinda Pitman's divorced husband, who employed the lawyers, allowed \$1,000.
