REFUSES TO SHOW HIS AGE

Farmer Near End Still Harnesses
 and Drives Fast Team of Horses
 Special to The World.

END, Feb. 18.—Although 89
 years of age, Lewis Osborn, a farmer
 east of End, harnesses a team of
 Irish horses several times weekly
 and hitches them to a spring wagon
 driving to market here. His eightieth
 birthday fell last Sunday and
 he observed it by demonstrating to
 a party of guests how easy it was for
 him to draw water from a well with
 a wheelbarrow.

Osborn is a native of Illinois and
 came to Oklahoma a few weeks after
 the Cherokee Outlet run in 1892.
 He served in the Union army during
 the Civil war and draws a pension
 of \$12 monthly. Recently he received
 an extra \$600 check from Uncle Sam.
