Fourteen dollars per month, to commence on the third day of December one thousand eight hundred and eighty seven, and Twenty two dollars per month from August 27, 1888 and Twenty five dollars per month from October 22, 1890.

This pension being for "Gross pharyngeal catarrh and resulting severe deafness of both ears resulting in total deafness of right ear and severe deafness of left ear."

Given at the Department of the Interior this eighteenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and ninety and of the Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and fifteenth.
