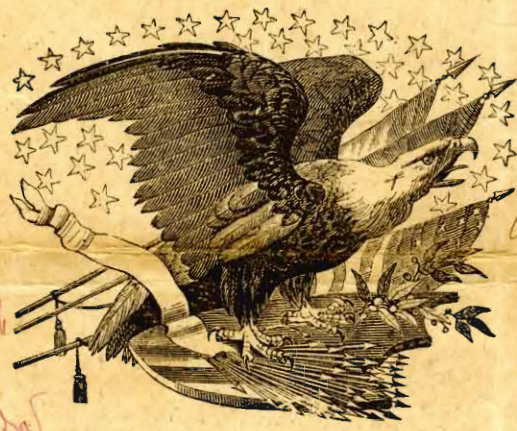

Sergeant of Captain Ahlrecher
Company, (F.) 2nd Regiment of Indian Home Guards
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Sixteenth day of November
one thousand eight hundred and Sixty-two to serve Three years or
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,
this Thirty-first day of May, 1865, at Fort
Gibson, C. N. by reason of Musters Out per P. O. No 110 A. D. Dept of Ark of 1865
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)*

Said Clark Ti-lar-jah was born in
in the State of Cherokee Nation, is Forty years of age,
Six feet — inches high, Red complexion, Black eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer

Given at Fort Gibson C. N. this Thirty-first day of
May 1865.

in the conduct or physical condition of the soldier
rendering him unfit for the Army.
