To all whom it may concern:

KNOW YE, That Johnson Lee a private of Captain James Vanns Company, (K) 3rd Regiment of Indian Home Guards volunteers who was enrolled on the 11th day of July 1862 to serve 3 years or during the war, is hereby discharged from the service of the U.S. this 31, day of May, 1865, at Fort Gibson Cherokee Nation by reason of muster out per S.O. No. 110, Hd Qrs Dept of Arkansas of 1865.

(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Johnson Lee was born in Cherokee Nation is 51 years of age 5feet 10inches high dark complexion black eyes black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a farmer.

Given at Fort Gibson C.N. this thirty first day of May, 1865.
