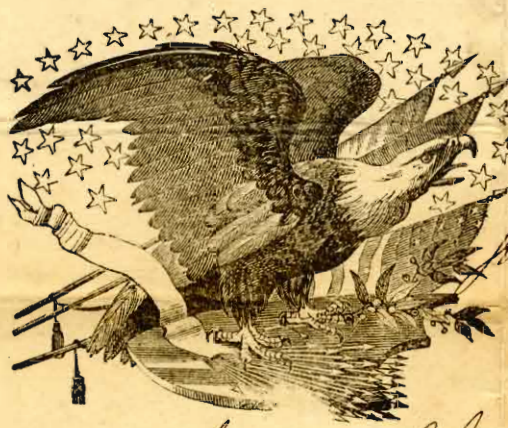

Know ye, That George Blomket  
Private of Captain Talalah

Company, (D.) Third Regiment of Indian Home Guards  
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Eleventh day of July  
one thousand eight hundred and sixty two to serve three years or  
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,  
this thirty first day of May, 1865, at Fort Gibson  
Cherokee N. by reason of muster out per G.O. No. 110 H. C. Lrs. Sept. 4th 1865  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)\*

Said George Blomket was born in Cherokee Nation  
in the State of Florida District, is 23 years of age,  
5 feet 4 inches high, Dark complexion, Black eyes,  
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer

Given at Fort Gibson Cal. this thirty first day of  
May 1865.
