Company, D., Third Regiment of Indian Home Guards.
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the ~~Elizabethtown~~ day of July
one thousand eight hundred and ~~sixty two~~ to serve ~~three~~ years or
during the war, is hereby Discharged from the service of the United States,
this thirty first day of May, 1865, at Fort Gibson
Charokee, N. by reason of muster out per S. O. No. 10 H. C. L. S. Dept. Ark 1865
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said George Blanket was born in Cherokee Nation
in the State of Flint District, is 23 years of age,
5 feet 4 inches high, Dark complexion, Black eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer

May 1865.
