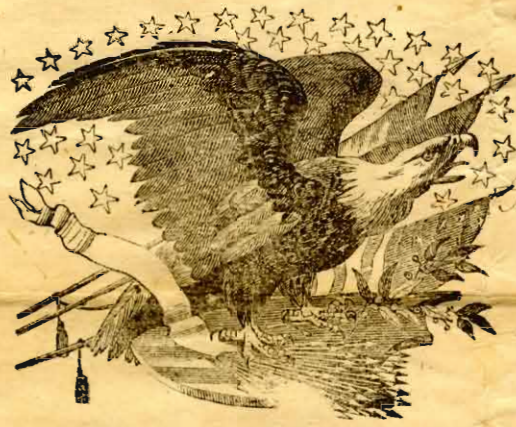

Paid in full this day of
August 21 1865 at Fort Gibson
Cherokee Nation.

Know ye, That Ni-hi-tu-yah-gah Paymaster U.S.A.
Private of Captain Moses Price
Company. (B.) 2nd Regiment of Indian Infantry Home Guards
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the Twentieth day of November
one thousand eight hundred and Sixty Two to serve Three years or
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States,
this Thirty First (31) day of May, 1865, at Fort Gibson
Cherokee Nation by reason of Mustered out for U.S. No 110 Hd qrs Dpt of Ark 1865
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Ni-hi-tu-yah-gah was born in Cherokee Nation
in the State of Indian Territory, is Sixteen years of age,
Five feet Six inches high, Red complexion, Black eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer

Given at Fort Gibson Ark, this Thirty First (31) day of
May 1865.
