Know ye, That Thomas Scott

4th Sergeant of Captain White Catcher
Company, (D.) 3rd Regiment of Indiana Infantry Home Guard
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the eleventh 11th day of July
one thousand eight hundred and sixty 60 to serve three (3) years or
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States
this thirty first (31st) day of May, 1865, at Fort Gibson,
Cherokee Nation by reason of Muster Out, Gen. O. R. No 110, Dept of Arkansas of 1865.
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Thomas Scott was born in Cherokee Nation
in the State of Georgia, is thirty (30) years of age,
five (5) feet six (6) inches high, Dark complexion, Blue eyes,
Black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Farmer
