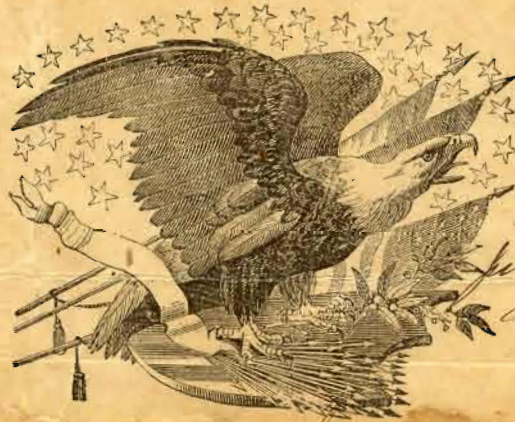

Know ye, That Tom a  
Private of Captain Talalah

Company, D, Third Regiment of Indian Infantry Home Guards  
VOLUNTEERS who was enrolled on the thirtieth day of July  
one thousand eight hundred and eighty two to serve three years or  
during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States.

this thirty first day of May, 1865, at Fort Gibson  
C. T. N. by reason of Mustered out per S. O. No. 11044. 2rs. Dept. Act. 1865.  
(No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said Tom was born in Cherokee Nation  
in the State of Georgia, is thirty four years of age,  
six feet seven inches high, dark complexion, black eyes,  
black hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a farmer

GIVEN at Fort Gibson this thirty first day of  
May 1865.
