After our Organization testified, at the State Capitol, April 2, 1991, against Senate Bill 8 & 9, for public pacification the local Newspaper printed another excuse for the Sheriff not doing his job: fighting crime and solving murders.

Since then, not one word has been printed, and Diane's murder is still unsolved. Diane King was not only a woman, but she was a Native American, who was, and still, being denied her civil rights.

If passed by the Michigan Legislature, these Prisons for Profit Bills, will destroy all Civil Rights, especially Women's
