If the Michigan Attorney General does not act on this injustice and see that the <u>real</u> murderer(s) is tried, we are asking you to bring it to the attention of the New U.S. Attorney General. For, neither the jury nor the national Court TV audience were made aware of the fact that we, the court room audience witnessed not only unjust and biased activity in the King Trial, but blatant cover up of <u>real evidence</u>: 12-1-92 the T.V. Channel 41 Accountant, Nancy Gwynne, was questioned by the Prosecutor and the Defense for a lengthhy time---more like two hours. When the jury was allowed to return to the court room, Nancy Gwynne's testimony was deleted to just a few trivial and meaningless words.

The jury was only permitted to hear the Prosecutor's untruthful summary where he dramatized that Diane was <u>quitting</u> her job to stay home and care for her children <u>and</u> that Brad King had murdered Diane because of the loss of income.
