Nomination Form

The Heinz Awards recognize outstanding Americans who have made significant contributions to one of the five areas in which John Heinz was most involved: Arts and Humanities, the Environment, Public Policy, the Human Condition, and Technology and Economic Growth. Recipients in each category will receive an unrestricted cash award of \$250,000.

Nominations are accepted only from a select group of individuals and your participation in this program will remain anonymous during the nomination period. The identity of your nominee (and any information concerning your nominee) should remain confidential. Juries will review all nominations and make recommendations to the Board of Directors for final selection. You are permitted to nominate as many appropriate individuals as you are able to identify. Nominators may not nominate themselves or their family members. You may copy this form or call the Heinz Family Foundation for additional copies.

Nominations for the 1994 Heinz Awards must be received no later than July 1, 1994.
