P.J. Workman has been re-scheduled to Tuesday, November 22nd. Today, we will be in the Duncan/Lawton areas.

We wanted to do aerial shooting November 10th, 11th and 15th, however, Mr. Tom Tucker did not confirm with us. Ellen spoke with him on Friday, November 5th, and requested he call Billy on Monday, November 8th. Since he was to be in Oklahoma City, we agreed it would be the best time to confirm aerial requirements and the upcoming filming. We waited all day for his call. We even left messages at his office in Tahlequah and at his home. He did not call us or meet with us at our studios. We still have not heard anything.

Therefore, we are scrapping the aerial shots until a later time. Would you please ask Mr. Tucker to call us this Friday so we might determine a final plan. We will return to our offices on Thursday, November 11th.
