We are eagerly preparing for our Fourth and final Gathering of the 1994 Class of Ambassadors which will embody the international aspect of the Program. The Gathering will be held in Cuernavaca, Morelos, Mexico. We plan to meet with Indigenous leaders and hear presentations about the Indigenous movements in Mexico. We want the Ambassadors to learn more about the rich Mexican Indian cultures and histories and how their history and struggle effects Indians in the United States. We hope to have some of our International Advisors join us in Mexico to make presentations to the group and to help in developing future international projects. In addition, we will finish the TIMS process and receive progress reports on the Ambassadors Field Projects.

Recruitment materials are currently being revised and readied for the 1994 Class of Ambassadors. Applications will be mailed out in mid-September and will be due December 15, 1993. Please spread the word about the Program to interested parties and have all likely candidates call or write AIO for more information. Because last year our response from the Southeast and Northeast regions was low, we are particularly interested in boosting our efforts in these two areas.
