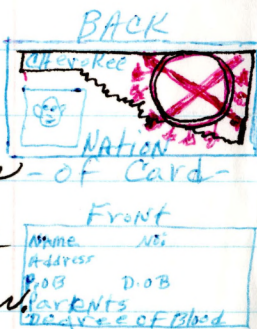
Dear Chief Mankiller;
