

ADDENDUM ITEM—RECENT VISIT WITH TEWA WOMEN UNITED ON JUNE VISIT

Wilma—

I met yesterday with three representatives from Tewa Women United, the grassroots women's organization operating among the Eight Northern Pueblos (among the six TEWA speaking pueblos). In this group were two granddaughters of Maria Martinez and one long time community leader from San Ildefonso. These women have been communicating with me for several months about their desire to interact with you informally around a host of basic issues—what I would call women's empowerment issues. They know you are speaking in New Mexico on June 19th and they would like to have an informal potluck dinner with you at San Ildefonso on the night of June 18th.

Remember I had you schedule yourself in here a day early to see the prestigious Albuquerque Academy, what many educators consider the top day school in all the southwest. The headmaster of this school has arranged to give you a detailed tour of all the facilities (by golf cart) and have you meet with members of the leadership team for curriculum and programs. This is where Meghan goes to school and I believe there is nothing comparable to it in Oklahoma, New Mexico or Arizona. They constructed a new 16 million dollar science building, and a 13 million dollar addition to their library last year alone. these are state of the art facilities.

I will talk about all this in more detail when I see you next.
