

STUDENT DISCRIMINATION GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

18. This decision may be appealed by the complainant or the person(s) named in the complaint. An appeal must be made, in writing, to the President of the University requesting that the decision be reviewed. Within ten (10) days after receipt of the written request, the President shall review the decision and all supportive materials. The President will make an official decision. The decision may be to support the decision of the Vice-President or HSC Officer. If the President cannot support the Vice-President's or

HSC Officer's decision, he/she may conduct an independent investigation. The President shall send a written account of his/her decision to the Vice President for Student Affairs or HSC Officer, the Chairperson of the Grievance Committee, the complainant and each person named in the complaint. The President's decision to support the decision and recommendations in whole or in part, or not to support the decision and recommendations will end the internal processes for settlement of the grievance.
