Dear Mr. Tyon:

On April 22, 1993, the Office for Civil Rights (OCR), Region VI, received the additional information necessary to complete the complaint in which you alleged discrimination by the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center (UOHSC). Based on our preliminary review of your original complaint and the additional information provided, it is my understanding that you are alleging that the UOHSC:

- 1) assigned you a grade of "C" in clinical radiology (RLTN 3460) on the basis of your national origin;
- suspended you and two other minority male students from the radiologic technology program in December 1992 on the bases of race/national origin and sex; and
- denied you and two other minority male students due process regarding the suspensions on the bases of race/national origin and sex.

OCR determined that allegation #1 was not filed with this Office within the 180-day filing limit. Our procedures provide for the granting of a waiver of the filing limit in certain instances. However, based on the information received from you regarding the reason allegation #1 was filed untimely, the OCR Regional Director, Mr. Taylor D. August, denied your request for a waiver. Therefore, we will continue to process your complaint only with regard to allegations #2 and #3, as outlined above.

This agency is responsible for determining whether organizations that receive or benefit from Federal financial assistance from the Department of Education or an agency that has delegated investigative authority to this Department are in compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. § 2000d, which states:
