It is uncanning how similar the two of you looked like at the time. I have shown your pretures to several people, including my parents. Everyone immediately comments how much you look like my sister, in your early years. I have enclosed a photo of her taken in 1961. While this photo really doesn't do the similar ties justice, it will give you the idea. Shortly after this photo was taken, she began wearing her hair long—more like yours.
