SEMINOLES IMPEACH GOVERNOR HARRISON

Wewooka, I. T., May 6.

Governor Jacob Harrison of the Seminoles has been impeached for incompetency by the council.

Ex-Governor John M. Brown, for many years the head of the nation, has been elected to fill the vacancy.

The council met yesterday and impeached the acting governor and then unanimously elected Ex-Governor Brown to the position.

Harrison succeeded Governor Halputter Mico as principal chief upon the latter's death some weeks ago, as he was the second chief, or lieutenant governor elected at the last regular election.

Governor Brown will serve until the termination of the present tribal relations. He has been very prominent in the past in all the transactions had be-
